### BPW Scholarships Report for 2010

In 2010 BPW awarded a record number of 229 scholarships to young women across 34 PNG based secondary, tertiary and vocational training institutions to the value of K158,251, plus some advanced payments to institutions for 2011 scholarships making the total amount paid in 2011 K162,800.

BPW is a volunteer organisation that awards partial scholarships for beneficiaries studying year ten and above, who with the support of their institution demonstrate financial challenges in meeting their annual fee commitments.

Since 2008 the number of scholarship recipients has increased by 435% and the total value of scholarships issued by 206%. The annual numbers and percentage increases in scholarships awarded since 2008 is represented in the table below.
