This will briefly repeat five of the topics covered in the first statement (constitutional and legislative framework, indigenous people's rights, economic and social rights, human rights and climate change, and NZ's voluntary pledge) and refer to two new topics: the women, peace and security national action plan; and concerns about proposed changes to the Arms Act.


BPW NZ is part of the UN Women's WEPs committee. President Janet attended a presentation to interested parties on the Seven Principles of Empowerment.


